Thank you for your interest in Champions for Life Kids' Camp 2018! Whether you heard about us through a friend, family member or the web, it's important that you understand our objectives and the serious nature of working with abused children. We take every precaution to make sure this is a "safe" camp for all who attend.

Each new applicant will be scheduled for a half-hour interview either by the CFL Directors or Connie Carpenter, and will be given, at that time, a Child Abuse/Neglect Central Registry clearance form to be submitted to the Department of Human Services prior to acceptance as a camp volunteer. Also, each new volunteer is required to attend approximately 16 hours of training to work with Wards of the State. The Florida team will do a mixture of training through videos recorded at the meetings in Michigan as well as team meetings here.

Per our agreement with the Department of Human Services, ALL MEETINGS ARE MANDATORY for new volunteers

All applications are due back to Connie by Sunday, January 28th. You will be contacted shortly after receipt of your application to set up your interview day and time.
